## **LICOP Cocoa Learning Journey**

Overview	Learning journeys are an opportunity to see and connect with what's happening "first hand" and to speak directly to producers and their communities. This learning journey will have approximately 15-20 attendees, representing diverse supply chain stakeholders, including chocolate companies, buyers, and implementing organizations. LICOP is partnering with the USDA program Colombian Cacao and Complementary Crops for Development (C4D) for this trip. We will also be visiting farms that are part of the Rabobank ACORN platform and have implemented agroforestry systems and climate smart practices.
Goal	Open, honest dialog to better understand challenges and opportunities for living income initiatives for cocoa farmers in Colombia and Latin America more broadly.
